➤ ABOUT THE CLASSROOM MUSIC PERFORMANCE MODEL

ChiME's Performance Model of the Classroom Music program is delivered in weekly sessions in groups from 5 to 30 participants during the school day throughout the school year. Each session ranges from 30 to 60 minutes, depending on the needs of each partner school. ChiME provides loaner instruments for use during classes; schools can also purchase their own instruments. ChiME teaching artists are able to deliver the content via in-person, remote, or hybrid model to engage, excite, and encourage active music making for every student.

Through our Performance Model Classroom Music classes ChiME aspires to:

- instill a love of music in every student
- help each student develop foundational musical skills
- stimulate self and social growth through the acquisition of life skills, including self-confidence, self-expression, collaboration, communication, relationship-building, and creativity, all of which support individual effectiveness and human development.

As a result, students:

- experience the joy of music making
- practice foundational music skills with voices and on instruments
- learn a diverse repertoire that includes age-appropriate, high-energy, and culturally diverse songs from a variety of genres.
- develop important life skills that support individual effectiveness and help them reach their true potential

- develop a sense of being part of a community
- perform with effective stage presence (where applicable/expected)
- begin developing an understanding of the value of diversity

➤ **ABOUT CHIME TIME RHYTHM & RHYME**

ChiME Time Rhythm & Rhyme engages younger students through songs, games, dances, and musical movement activities. This program focuses on developing communication, self-expression, self-confidence, and social engagement through music. Students will learn, explore, and create music in a student-centered, collaborative environment led by a ChiME teaching artist. For schools where students receive classroom music instruction during the school day, ChiME Time Rhythm & Rhyme creates opportunities for a deeper level of engagement and learning.

➤ **SHORT- & LONG-TERM STUDENT OUTCOMES**

Short-Term Outcomes

- Students will practice social engagement skills such as listening, turn-taking, and collaborating.
- Students will explore and perform foundational music skills such as steady beat, rhythm, dynamics, and singing.
- Students will create music, lyrics, and/or movements independently and as a group.

➤ ABOUT CHIME TIME DRUMLINE

ChiME Time Drumline engages students in 3rd grade and up in an after-school drumline-like percussion ensemble. The program focuses on developing self-effectiveness, leadership, and relationship building skills through music. Students will learn, rehearse, and perform music in a high-energy, collaboration-centered environment led by a ChiME teaching artist. For schools where students receive classroom music instruction during the school day, ChiME Time Drumline creates opportunities for a deeper level of engagement and learning.

➤ SHORT- & LONG-TERM STUDENT OUTCOMES

Short-Term Outcomes

- Students will develop an awareness and appreciation of leadership and self-effectiveness skills.
- Students will increase their level of self-effectiveness, including in the areas of prioritizing, planning, time management, and accountability.
- Students will demonstrate increased leadership by fulfilling their roles and responsibilities within the ensemble and becoming role models to younger peers.
- Students will gain instrumental skills.
- Students will polish several musical selections on their assigned instruments for a performance as an ensemble.

- Students will develop appreciation of various musical genres.
- Students will gain skills for effective communication and confident self-expression.
- Students will learn how to effectively present a performance for an audience.
